1. Apologies were received from District Cllr Sampson
2. **Minutes of the Last Meeting**
The Minutes of the meeting held on 18th May 2015 were approved.
3. **Matters Arising**

4. **Finance Report**
The Clerk reported that the finances of the Parish Council were healthy and that the annual audit was due with the Auditor on 17th June 2015. The Audit had been passed by the Councillors and was now due with the village internal auditor.

5. **Chairman's Report**

The Chairman reported that 6 meetings of the Council had been held during the year and that some good work had been achieved.
The village defibrillator was in place and this had only taken just over a year to discuss, fund raise and install. Training was due to commence very shortly.
The Neighbourhood Plan approval had been achieved on the 2nd July 2015 and the Plan adopted by SKDC. It had already been quoted at planning appeals and was an excellent piece of work.
Although the RWE wind farm planning application had been refused when the last Annual Parish Meeting was held, it was not known at that time if RWE would appeal this decision. They had not appealed.
The Passive Speed Signs had been approved by the Authority and the signs installed. However, it was now time to take them down for a brief period of time in order to conform with the legislation relating to their use. It was agreed to arrange a date for a small group to carry out this task.
Various small planning applications relating to properties in the village had been passed. However, the Straw Storage application for storage on Fulbeck Airfield was still outstanding.
Cllr Davis had organised the flagpole nomenclature signs and these were a great success.
