1. Apologies were received from Mrs L Stevenson
2. **Minutes of the Last Meeting**
The Minutes of the meeting held on 19th May 2014 were approved.
3. **Matters Arising**
 - 3.1 The Church Yard mowing team has been organised and is working well.
 - 3.2 The VAT on the invoices relating to the Neighbourhood Plan had been recovered.
4. **Finance Report**
The Clerk reported that the finances of the Parish Council were healthy and that the annual audit was due with the Auditor on 15th June 2015. The Audit had been passed by the Councillors and was now due with the village internal auditor.

5. **Chairman's Report**
The Chairman welcomed Cllr Davis as a newly, officially elected Councillor. He reported on the great achievement, due to a lot of hard work, of getting the RWE planning application refused and mentioned particularly the exceptional piece of work carried out by Roger Kingscott of Brandon who wrote the reVOLT rebuttal document. A good meeting had been held with Robert Hall and Ben Wills of Beeswax and this relationship was being progressed.
There had been 3 planning applications during the past year, all for The Rectory. The PC had agreed to all of these but had asked for a condition that all materials should be delivered via the main Rectory entrance, not down Church Lane. A Condition had not been granted, only a recommendation which, unfortunately, had not been taken up.
6. **Open Forum**
 - 6.1 Mr Rose asked that the grateful thanks of the Church and PCC for the grass cutting team be noted.
 - 6.2 District Cllr Sampson made the meeting aware of a Northern Cluster Meeting relating to potential wind farm developments was being held on 23rd June 2015. Two reps per parish would be invited; the speakers were Roger Kingscott, Paul Miley and Melvin Grosvenor. Further details would follow shortly.
